

## Application for the Palo Alto Transportation Management Association Advisory Committee

The Palo Alto Transportation Management Association (TMA), invites individuals to apply to serve on an Advisory Committee. Each member will represent one or more specific stakeholder groups. The Advisory Committee will consist of up to five members who will participate in TMA Board meetings, serve as TMA 'ambassadors' in their respective communities, provide information to and advocate on behalf of the TMA in their communities, and provide the TMA with feedback from the community. At least one member will be asked to attend Board meetings and report back to other Advisors. Committee members will be asked to serve for either a one or two-year term.

In 2016, the TMA Board expects to meet on a monthly basis from July through December. In 2017, Board meetings may be scheduled on a quarterly or monthly basis. The Board normally meets on Thursdays, between 1pm and 4pm.

- Residents who live Downtown and work outside of Downtown
- Residents who live in a neighborhood adjacent to the Downtown area, as defined by the Residential Parking Permit boundaries
- Residents of Palo Alto (not Downtown) who work Downtown
